### Guidance for Child Visitation

#### **Encourage Volunteers to Stay in Touch:**

While volunteers are not able to meet in person with children at this time, consider advising them to replace visits with texts and phone calls, so that the communication with children continues, if possible. Encourage traditional activities such as handwritten letters and cards. #### Follow the Guidance of Your Local Court System:

State government offices, court systems and other organizations you work with will likely come up with strategies to continue to support the children you serve. If offered, encourage volunteers to take advantage of options to call or video conference into permanency planning meetings and court hearings; Stay in touch with volunteers and advocates and exchange ideas about how to best support children and families during this difficult time.



### Exception to Standard on In-person Visitation

#### Standards for Local CASA/GAL Programs 2012 Version

Standard 7.E.5.f.- requires the volunteer to visit in-person with the child once every 30 days at a minimum. **Allows for an exception**:

"The CASA/GAL program assures that volunteers have regular and sufficient in-person contact with the child to enable them to have an in-depth knowledge of the case and make fact based recommendations to the court. The CASA/GAL volunteer shall meet in person with the child once every thirty (30) days at a minimum. An exception may be granted in the discretion of the CASA program staff; however, the decision to permit less frequent in person contact shall be documented as to the justification for and reasonableness of the exception."

Taking precautions and addressing these legitimate concerns by opting to exercise the exception due to the coronavirus is sufficient justification for documenting permission for volunteers to see children less often than that required by the Standard.



### Training Opportunities

#### **Alternative Options for In-person, Pre-service Volunteer Trainings Available**

National CASA/GAL made modifications to the 2018 Flex Learning Curriculum, so that it can be delivered in a totally virtual environment. **Work is currently underway to modify the traditional 30 hour in-person pre-service curriculum for virtual delivery.**
