If you suspect a youth is being trafficked...

- Do not assume sexual orientation of youth
- Refrain from using 'human trafficking', as it may unintentionally reinforce stigma or marginalize the youth
- Consult a male survivor ahead of time if possible, to staff youth's situation
- Connect youth to substance dependency and mental health services that serve BYMOC, BIPOC, YMSM and LGBTQ – **MaleSurvivor.org** serves as a national information portal for male survivors of sexualized violence and male-serving providers
- Do not try and rescue, but first empower the young person to take action themselves. Instead come alongside the youth and offer additional support

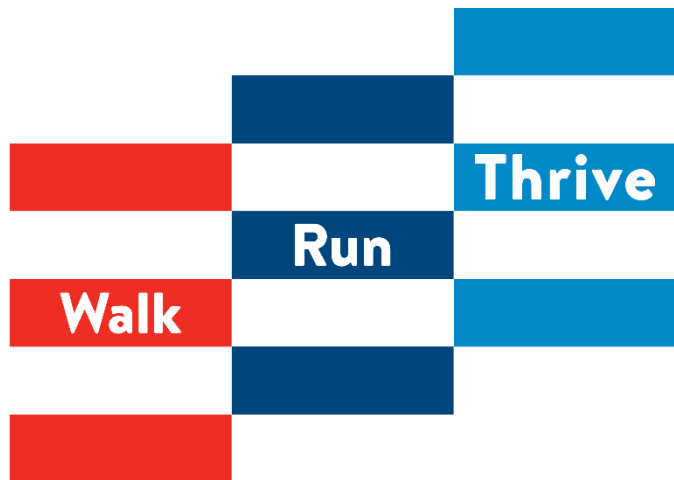

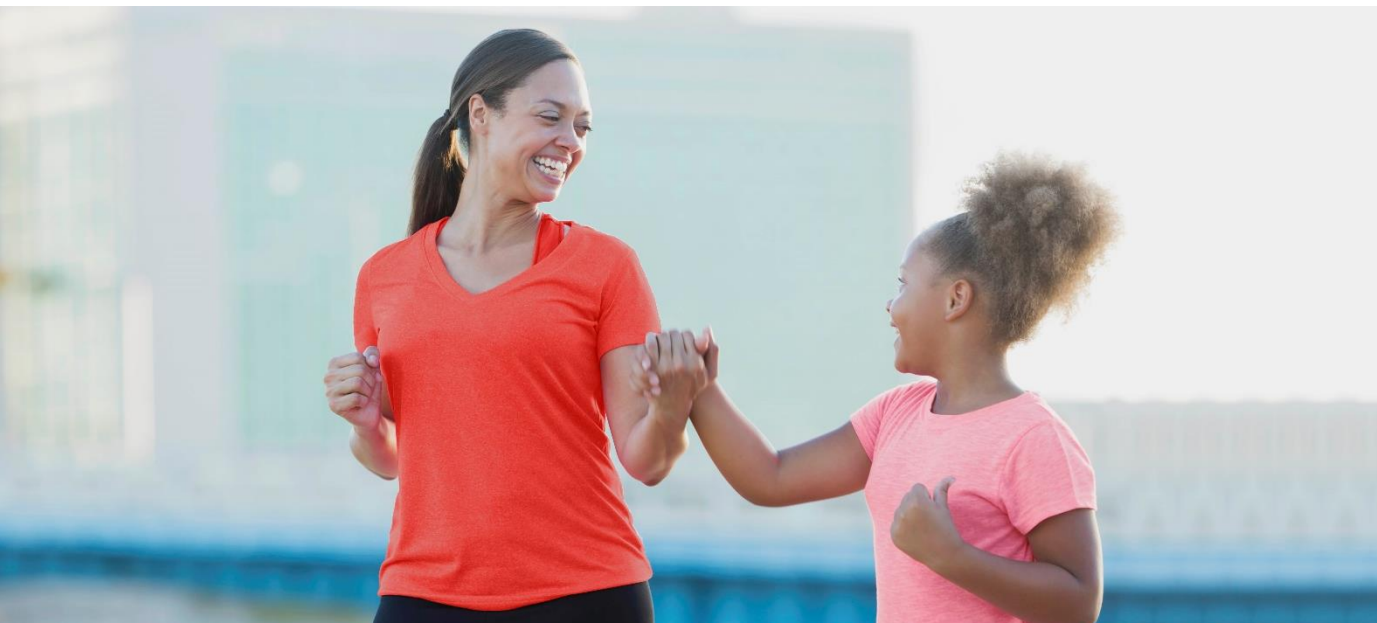
